Accomplishments of the Past Year

Successfully lobbied for Highway Trust Fund eligibility of both the Durham Loop Highway Trust Fund Projects and I-540 to the NC 55 bypass

Spearheaded a legislative effort to form a Blue Ribbon Study Commission on Urban Transportation Finance with guaranteed Alliance representation

Hosted monthly Regional Transportation Strategy (RTS) meetings with the mayors of Raleigh, Durham, Cary, and Chapel Hill and Alliance leadership

Received front-page coverage of the RTS initiative in *The News & Observer*

Increased organization participation to more than 80 members

Worked with the region's metropolitan planning organizations (MPOs) to identify specific projects for local funding

Developed traffic delay-reduction concepts with guidance from NCDOT Congestion Management staff


Met with key members of Congress at the U.S. Chamber of Commerce Transportation Priorities Conference

It has been a very successful year for the Regional Transportation Alliance. We have become the region's recognized business leadership organization for transportation,



and we have seen achievements in all facets of our inaugural business plan. The Alliance Steering Committee and our first-ever Executive Director, Joe Milazzo II, PE, are highly effective in leading our work. They are dedicated to serving you, our members and area chambers of commerce, as we work with our transportation partners to improve mobility in the Triangle. In addition, Katy Hipp, Project and Information Coordinator, was instrumental in developing the Alliance brand during our first year as a membership organization.

This year, the Alliance membership grew by over 30 percent, including the addition of new Silver member RSM McGladrey. We have also enjoyed success with our chamber of commerce outreach initiative, as eight area chambers of commerce—Apex, Fuquay-Varina, Garner, Hillsborough, Holly Springs, Knightdale, Morrisville, and Wendell—joined our organization.

The Alliance saw growing momentum for urban transportation solutions in the 2003 legislative session. We, along with our Chamber Partners, successfully lobbied for an amendment to the NC Moving Ahead legislation, which created a Blue Ribbon Study Commission on Urban Transportation Finance with guaranteed Alliance representation. In addition, we supported the funding of I-540 to the Holly Springs bypass and the Durham Loop Highway Trust Fund Projects, all of which were included in 2003 ratified legislation.

Regional Transportation Alliance members worked with both area metropolitan planning organizations (MPOs) to identify specific transportation projects and priorities to benefit from additional funding revenues. The Durham-Chapel Hill-Carrboro MPO has approved an illustrative list of projects, and the Capital Area MPO will continue to work with the Alliance Level of Service Subcommittee to include our needs as part of their long-range transportation plan update. We remain committed to helping our area MPOs provide the most effective transportation plans for our growing region.

We continue to foster partnerships with our region's elected leaders through the Alliance-facilitated Regional Transportation Strategy group of mayors from Raleigh, Durham, Cary, and Chapel Hill. The mayors have suggested several local funding options, and we are committed to working with them and the Blue Ribbon Study Commission to identify and present the best mobility funding solutions to the legislature. We have also strengthened relationships with NCDOT staff and board members, SmartCommute, Triangle Transit Authority, and other public and private transportation entities and providers.

It has been a pleasure to work with each of you as the Alliance has grown. Your focus, diligence, and dedication to both the organization and the region have been essential to our success. We are confident that the Regional Transportation Alliance will continue to provide the consistent *business* leadership that our members require and the Triangle deserves. Thank you for your support and membership.
