



**HURRICANE FLORENCE**

- Recovery efforts are underway on the NCRR line following Hurricane Florence.

**GROWING BUSINESS**

- Through its economic development initiative *NCRR Invests*, NCRR assisted in the recruitment of nine new or expanding rail-served companies in North Carolina, resulting in more than 2,000 jobs, more than \$12 M investment by NCRR, more than \$1.8 B investment by companies.

- Two of the largest rail-served projects:
  - **EGGER Wood Products**, 770 jobs, \$6.4 M investment by NCRR, \$700 M investment by the company.
  - **Triangle Tyre Company**, 800 jobs, \$2.5 M investment by NCRR, \$580 M investment by the company.



- The Greensboro-Randolph Megasite is actively being marketed and we continue to work with our partners in the recruitment of a large scale manufacturer.

**INVESTING IN NORTH CAROLINA**

- Construction is set to begin on the Crabtree Creek railroad bridge in Morrisville. The nearly 100-year-old bridge will be replaced and will include capacity for a second track.
- Modifications are also planned for railroad bridges in Durham.

**MOVING PEOPLE**

- NCRR continues to collaborate with Go Triangle, Wake County, Durham County and other partners on rail-transit oriented projects such as commuter rail and light rail.
