








2021 King Tides



Tidal Flooding Frequency is Trending Upward







2019 Unified Sea Level Rise (SLR) Projection for SE FL

 Adopted by City Commission May 2020 for Planning Purposes

- Sea Level Rise is accelerating.
- 2.5 feet NAVD City min elevation for infrastructure expected to last 50 years (2070)
 - E.g. elevation of transformer pads for Las Olas Undergrounding
- Suggests the City would have to raise select raodways by 12-18 inches minimum
- Roadway access impacts insurability
- Timing –CIP projects funded 5 years out...
- Elevating streets now will support the next mortgage cycle.

We are already seeing results!







1st Time Fort Lauderdale was named a **Top 18-Hour City** along peers like Denver, Charlotte, and San Diego.




DowntownFTL is an "Established Downtown" according to the International Downtown Association and has a city and countywide significance equal to Miami, San Francisco, and Seattle.






