Dear J.J.,

Thank you for evaluating various options to accelerate the US 1 / Capital Boulevard freeway.

On behalf of the Town of Wake Forest and RTA, we request the Turnpike Authority analyze the following time-of-day discounted toll framework for expressway (all lanes toll) scenarios 1 and 2:

Southbound US 1, towards I-540 and Raleigh:

- <u>S-1 Full toll rates:</u> Mon-Fri: 6 am 10 am
- <u>S-2 Discounted tolls:</u> Mon-Fri: 10 am 10 pm; Sat-Sun: 6 am 10 pm
- <u>S-3 No tolls charged:</u> Mon-Fri and Sat-Sun: 10 pm 6 am

Northbound US 1, towards Wake Forest and Franklin Co.:

- <u>N-1 Full toll rates:</u> Mon-Fri: 3 pm 7 pm
- <u>N-2 Discounted tolls:</u> Mon-Fri: 6 am 3 pm, 7 pm 10 pm; Sat-Sun: 6 am 10 pm
- <u>N-3 No tolls charged:</u> Mon-Fri and Sat-Sun: 10 pm 6 am

Observations and assumptions on the above discounted toll framework:

- We believe the above or similar framework will be viable for all "expressway" (all lanes toll) scenarios, as long as the project retains TIP funding from at least segments A and B.
- Full toll rates (periods S-1, N-1) would align with other Triangle Expressway system tolls.
- We understand that the level of discounts (periods S-2, N-2) will depend on the revenue analysis, with higher possible discounts if the project retains segments C and D funding.
- The above assumes a consistent time-of-day schedule, not variable or dynamic pricing.

We have previously requested consideration of time-of-day tolls (**attachments**). This letter adds specificity, including an extended discounted toll period to enhance operations and viability. We request that the results of the analysis be immediately incorporated into scenarios 1 and 2.
